7. Tell us about a time when you had a significant disagreement with another person, organization, or authority figure. How was the disagreement resolved? (We are looking for examples of personal transparency and teachability, not perfection.)
8. Have you applied to other Fellows programs or other opportunities elsewhere? Why is the Augustine Fellows pilot program attractive to you, and what you would hope to gain from being an Augustine Fellow?
9. Is there anything else that would be significant for us to know?
10. Resume: Please attach a current resume and/or provide some details of your work and volunteer experience (e.g., internships).
